BOARDING

We also want our parents/guardians to take note of the following:

- Henceforth, breezing in and breezing out of parents at any unwanted time will no longer be tolerated. Parents can only visit their ward(s) on visiting days.
- Handing over anything, be it eatables, drugs or materials without passing through the right channel for proper documentation will no longer be accommodated.
- Our Scholars are not allowed to keep money in the hostel. Parents should ensure that pocket money is properly documented in the cafeteria and not just transferring into boarding house master/mistress bank account without the knowledge of the Management. Our Scholars should be able to know what they have spent and what is remaining as balance in their cafeteria account.
- Boarders who are yet to submit their medical report should kindly do so. Parents/guardians should communicate their wards' health status to the School Management through the School Nurse at resumption for proper care and monitoring.
- Parents whose ward(s) have allergy to certain food and want to make alternative arrangement should approach the Management on/before resumption to discuss possible alternative food to be given and the cost implication.
- The Management enjoins parents to caution their wards not to be involved in any form of bullying activities within the school as any child caught bullying will be expelled from the hostel without refund of boarding fee.
- Parents/guardians are to take note that boarding fee is not refundable.

- The School Management will only allow scholars to go home during mid-term break and vacation. Boarding house students will no longer be given permit to go home frequently during the term.
- Parents are advised to go through boarding house requirement list and ensure their ward(s) come along with the right items at resumption.
